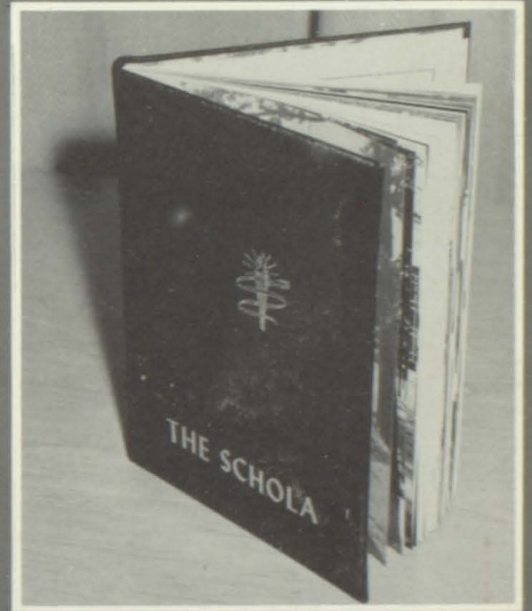
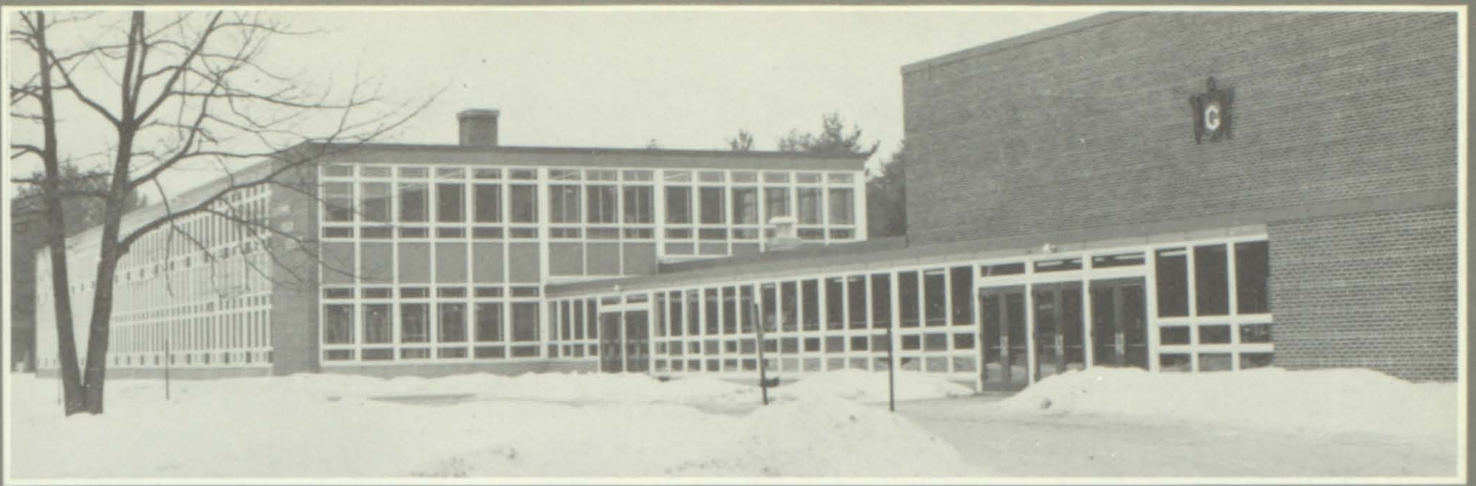
Theme

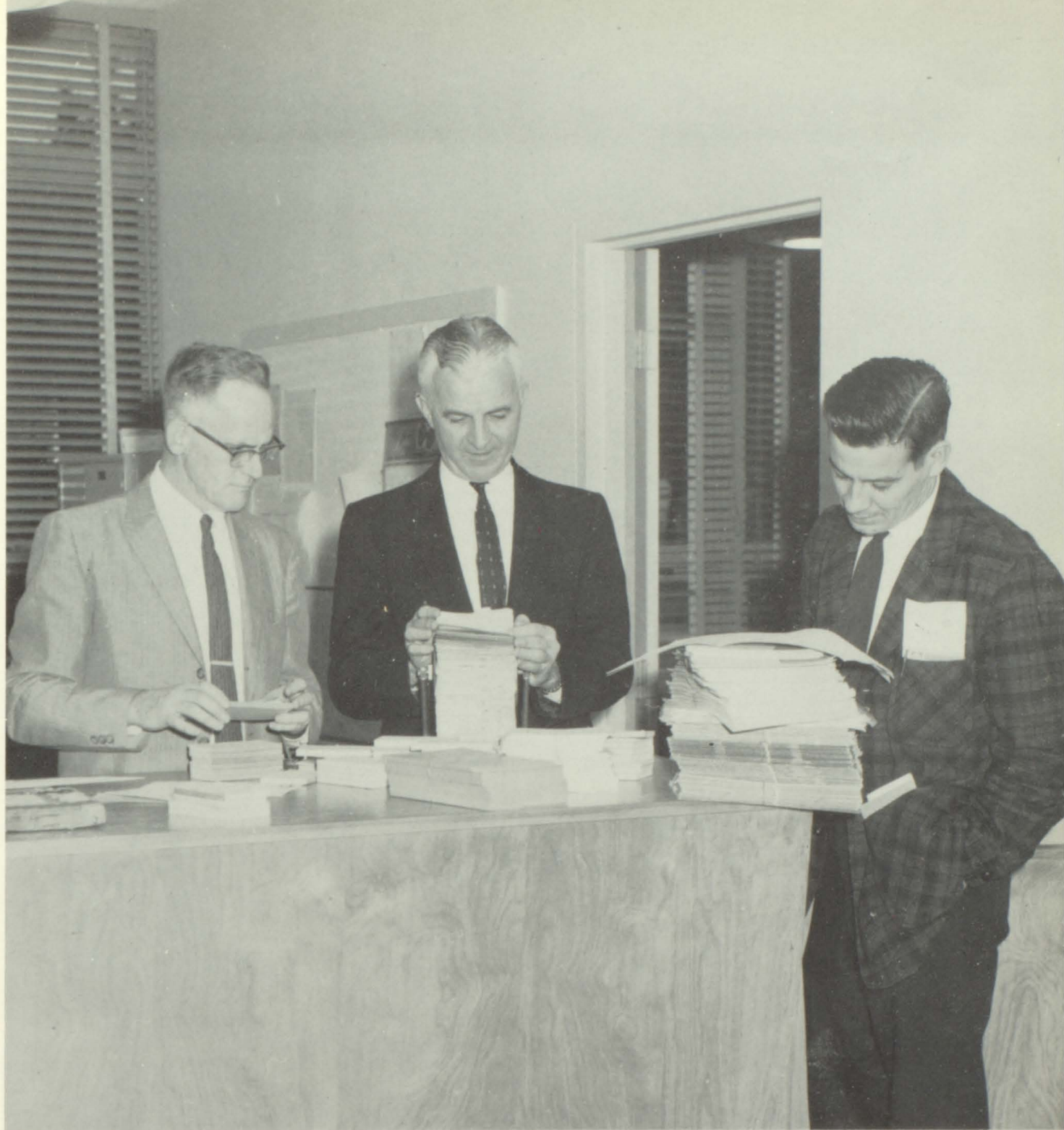


TO THE STUDENT BODY OF GORHAM HIGH SCHOOL
