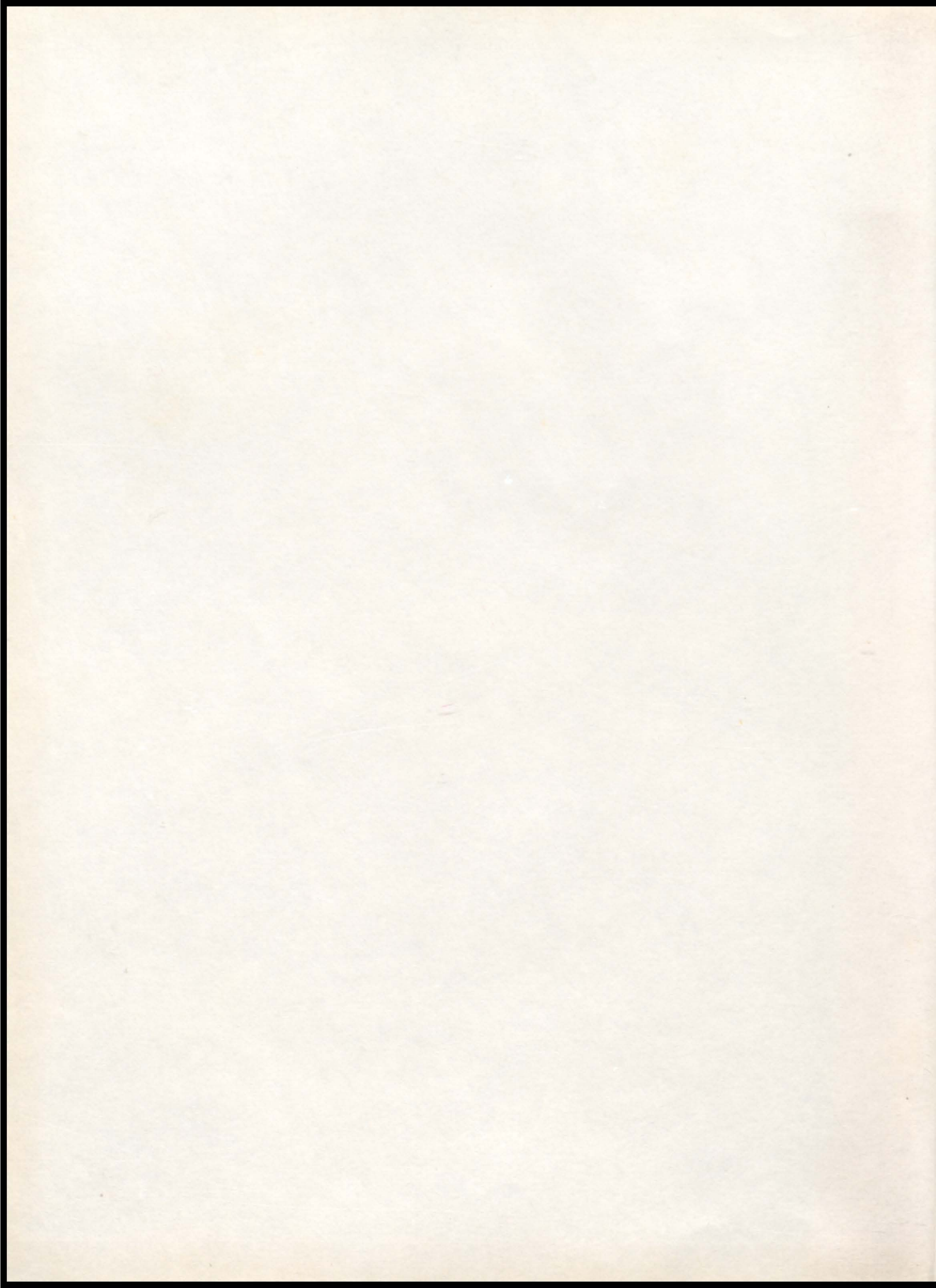

So — to the Future — may it be for all of us what we seek today.



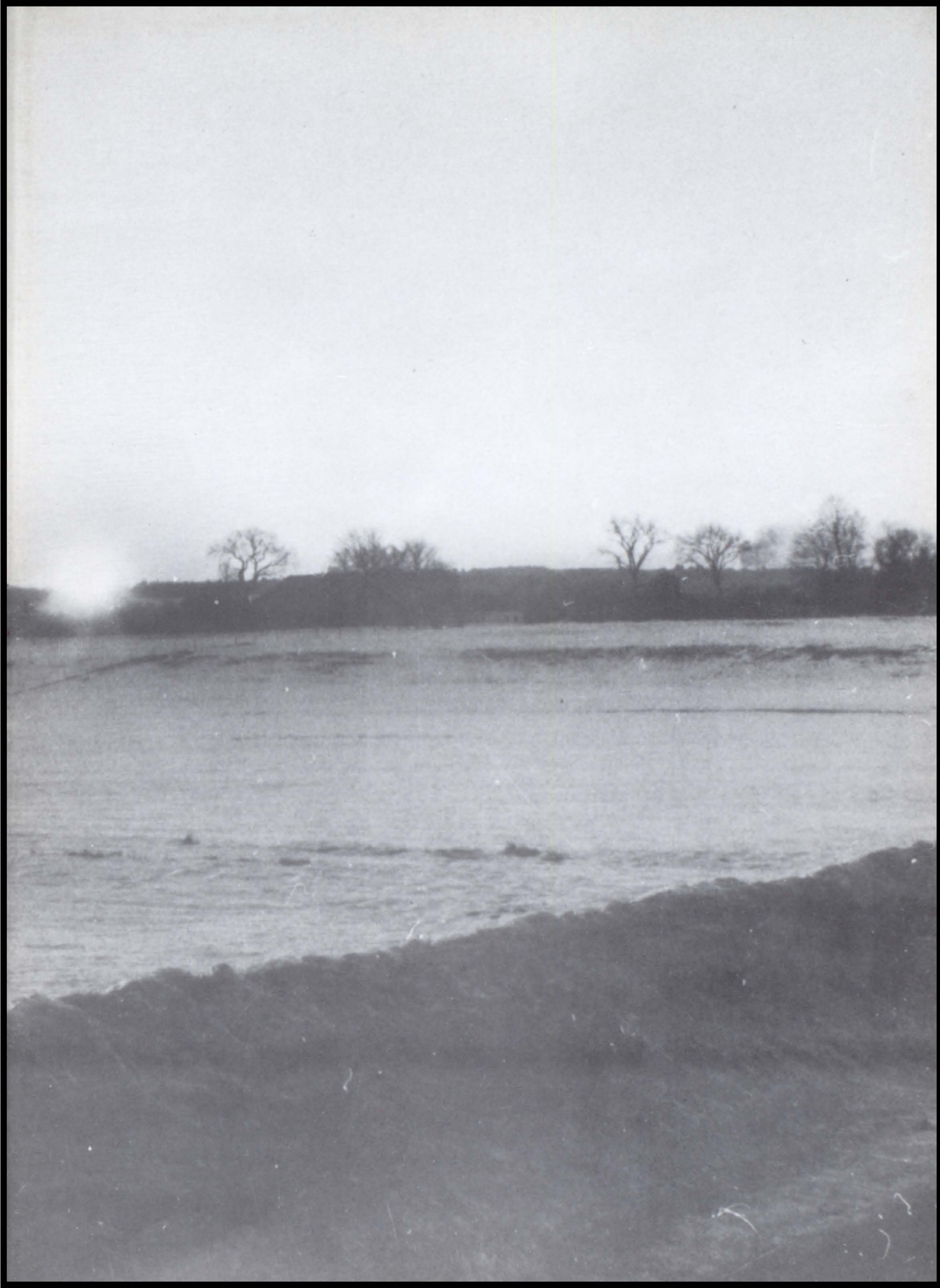

It is always a long hard pull for the team because they are inexperienced and new, but the team has made a good showing this year winning four out of ten games.

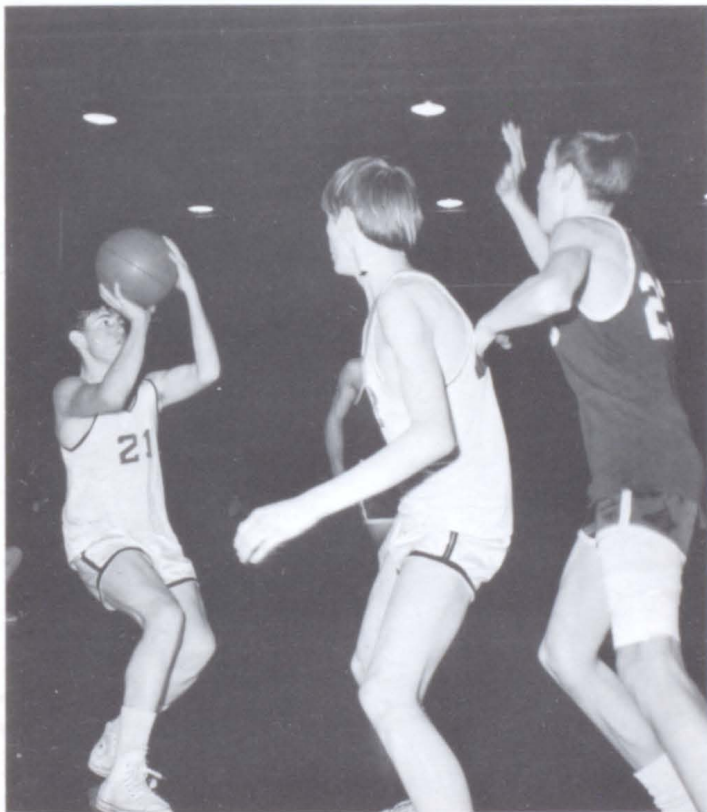

Above all else the Rams made the sport of basketball an enjoyable thing to watch through their skill, teamwork, sportsmanship and desire.

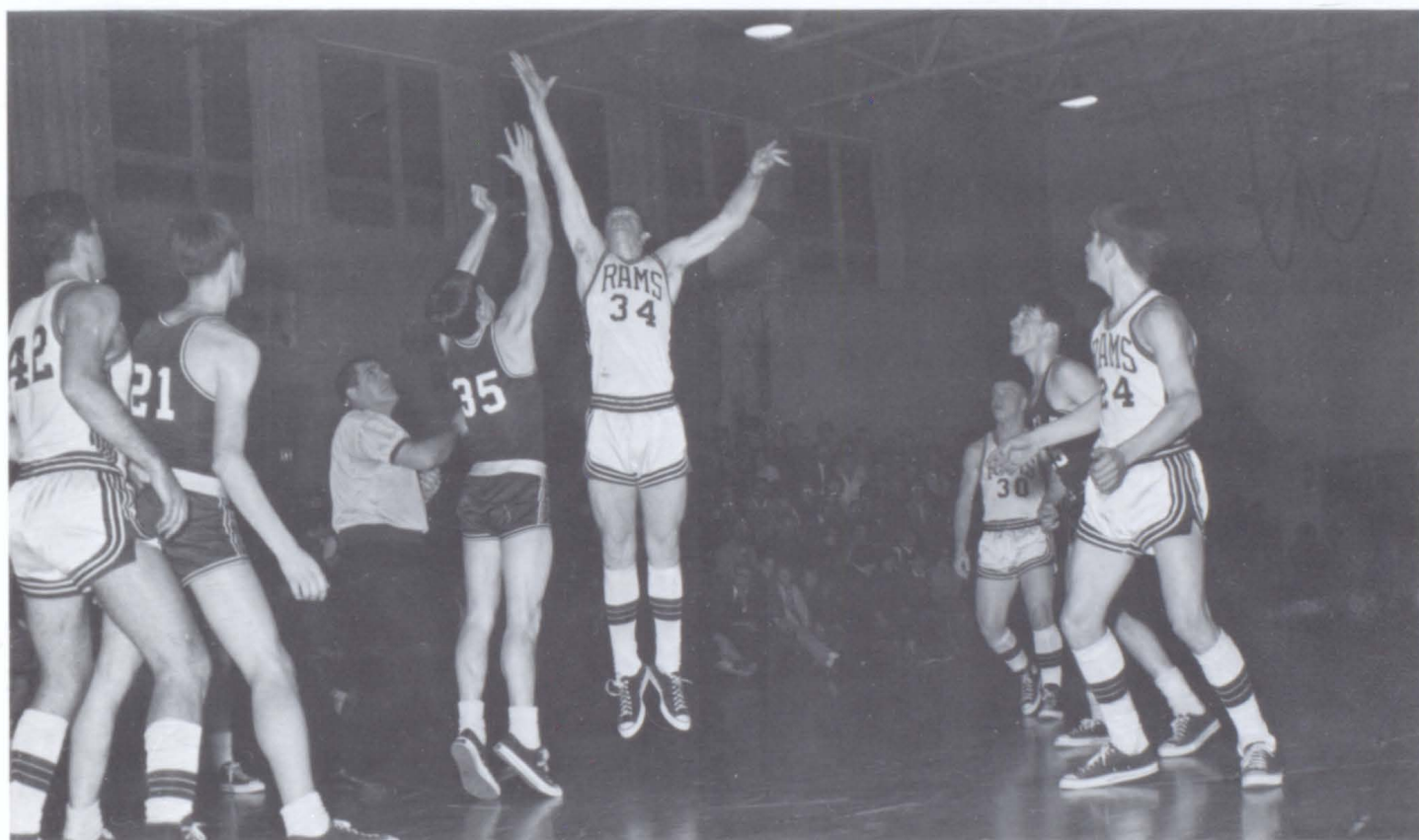

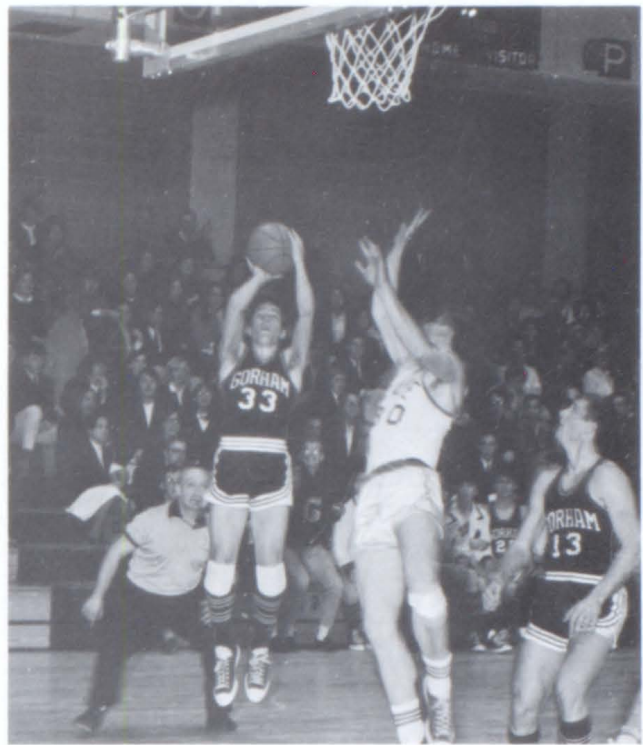
Dear Mr. Delano:
