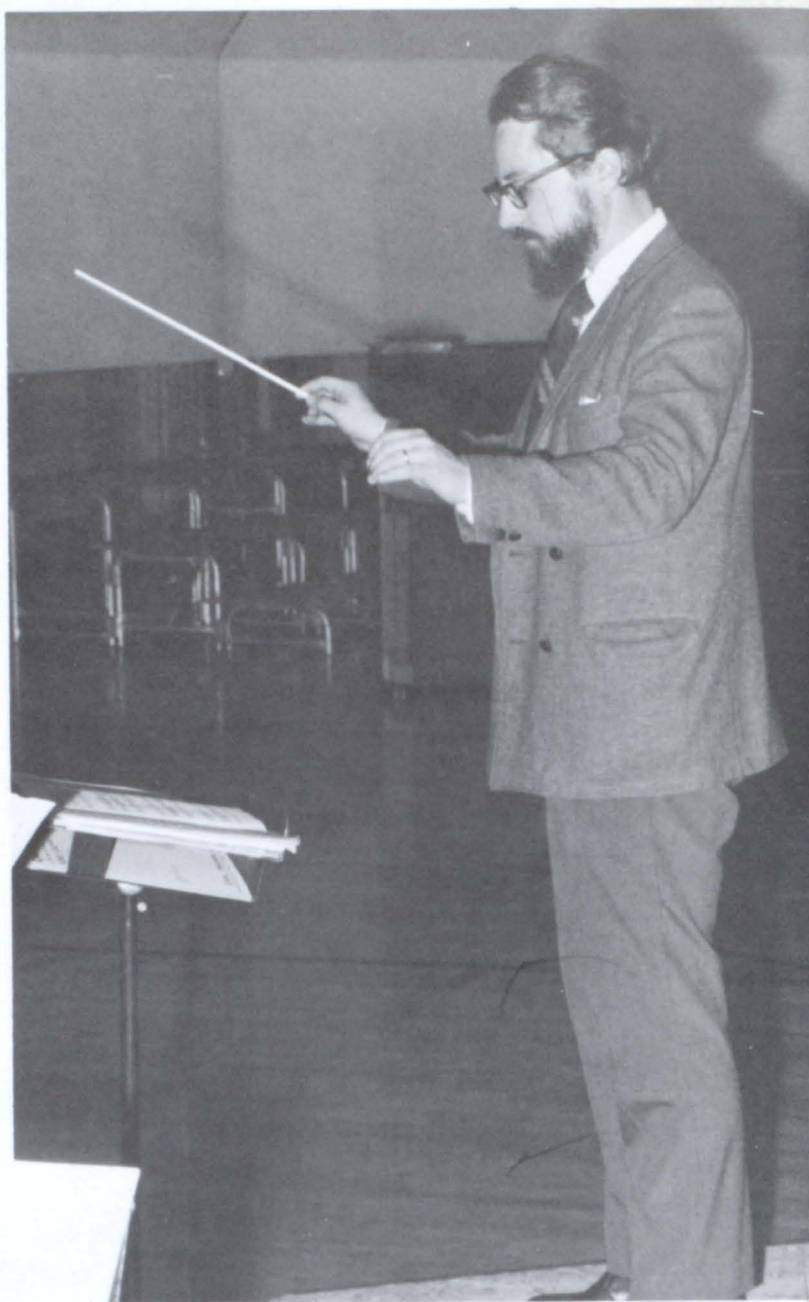
For each of them, the most important thing in living was to reach out and touch perfection in that they most loved to do.

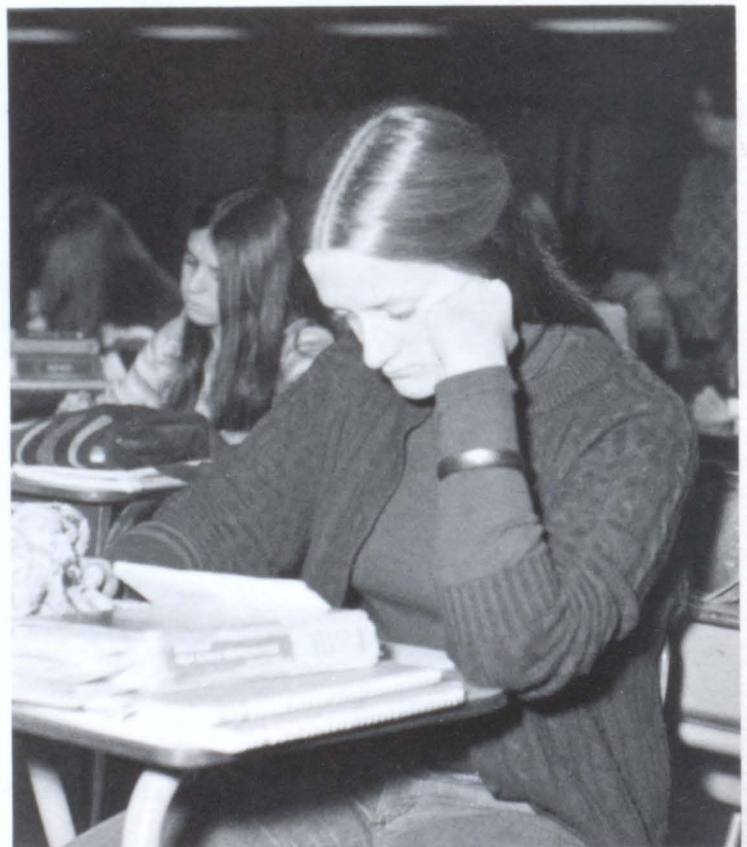

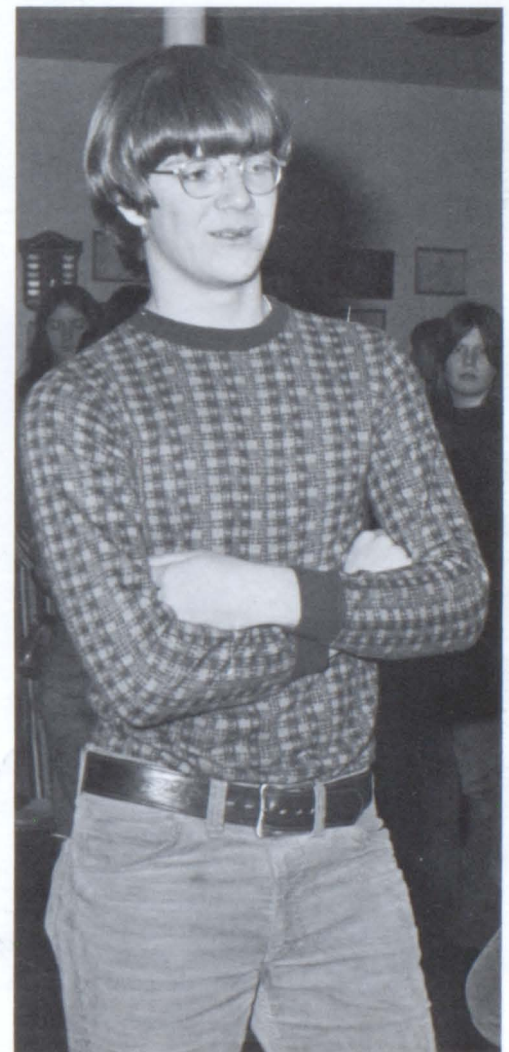

The president of the club, Jim Kramlich, thinks that this year will be the best since the club began.

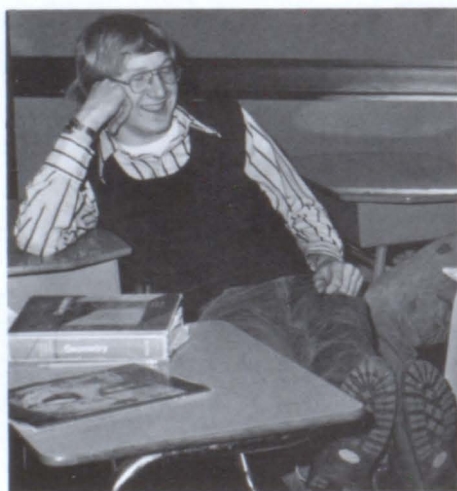

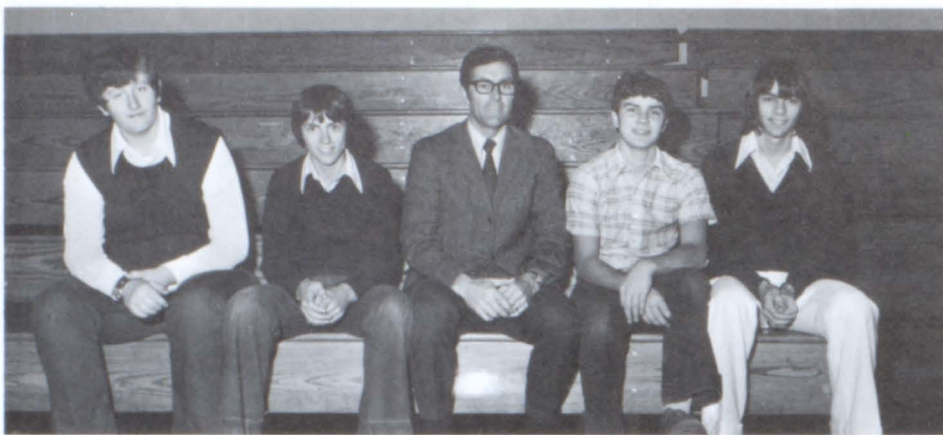
