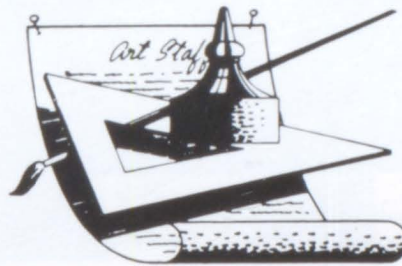
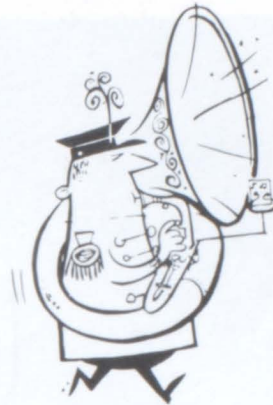
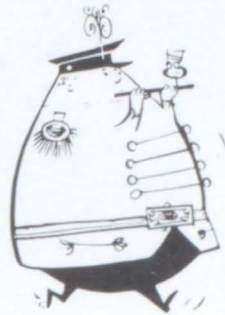


CLUBS
