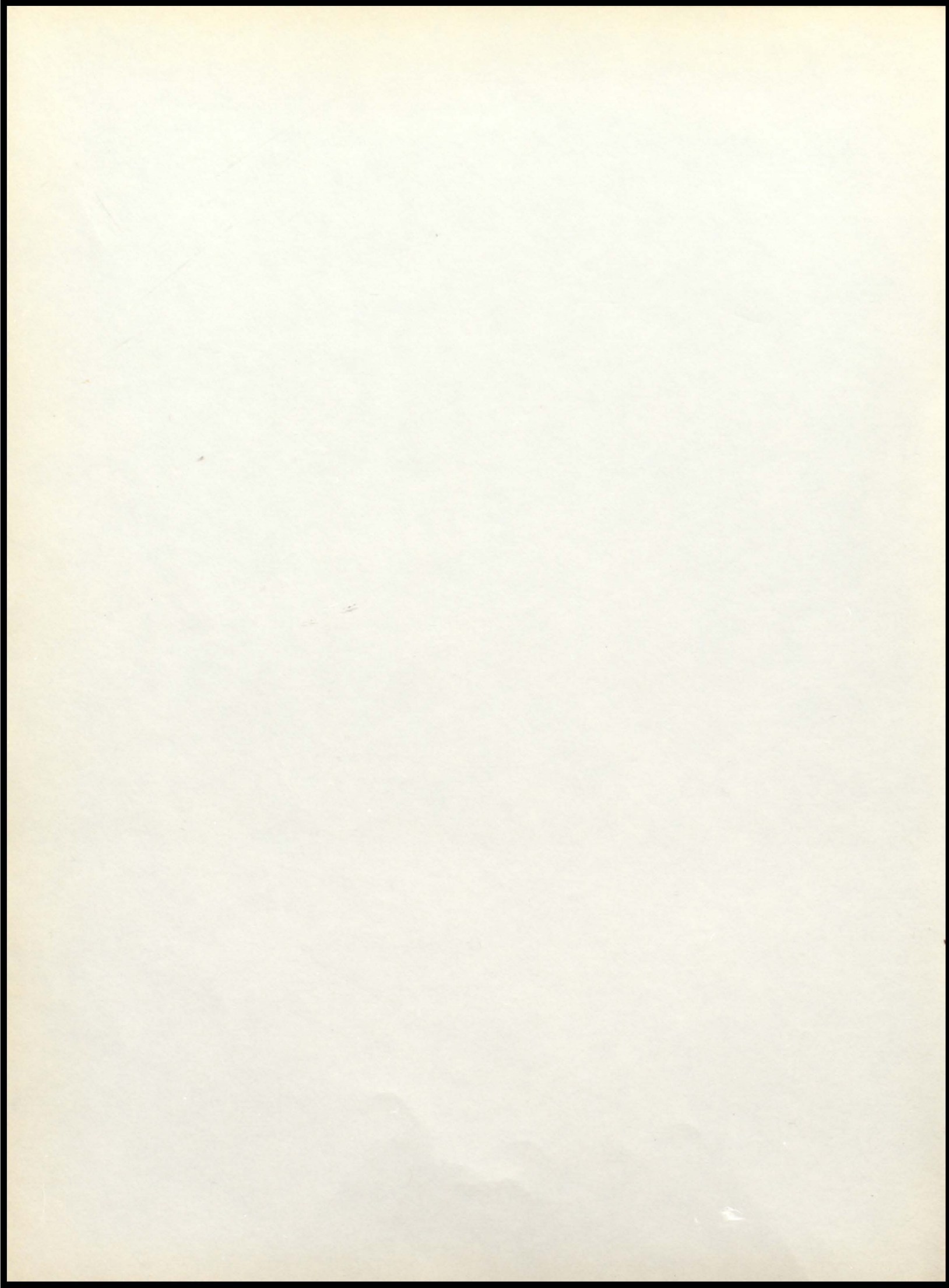

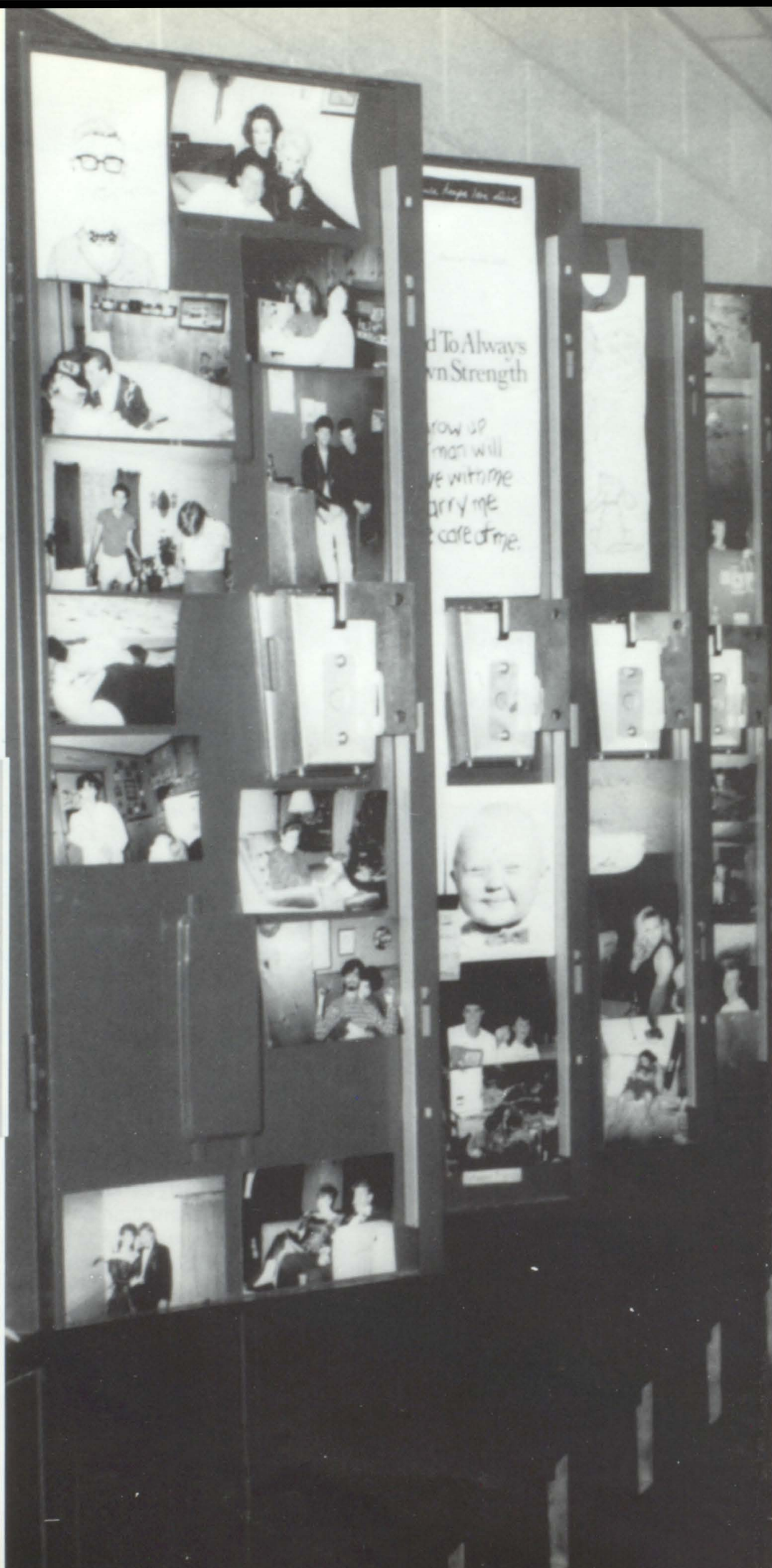

HOMECOMING



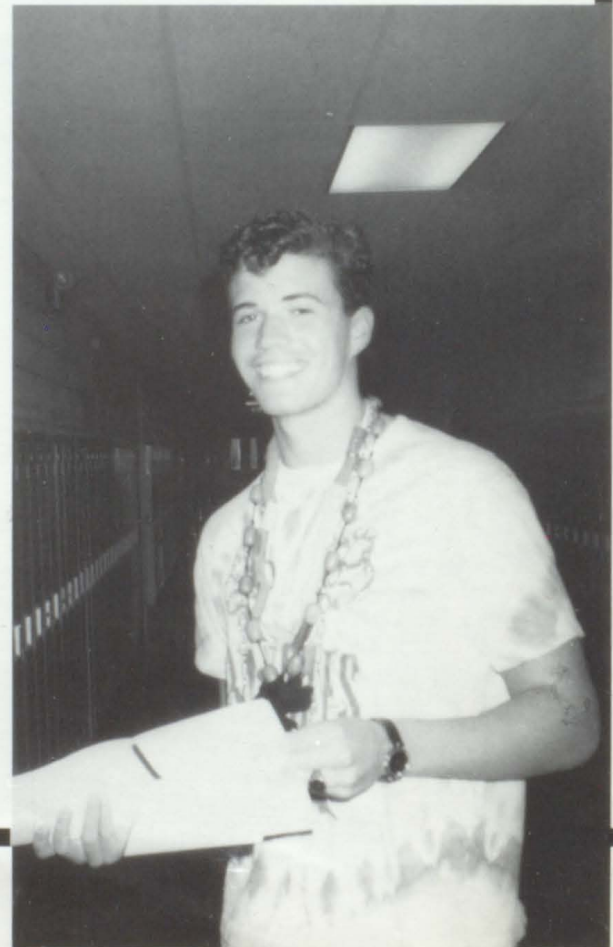

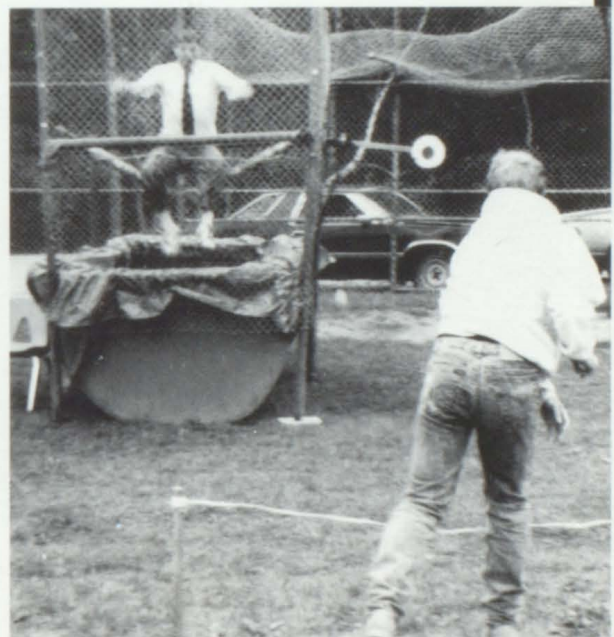
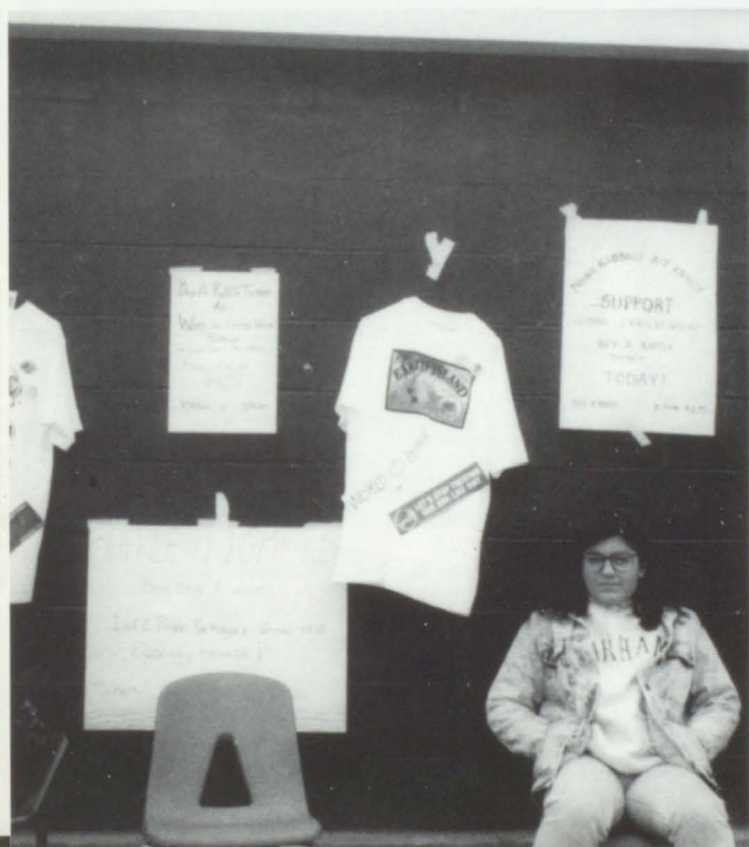

LOCK IN!

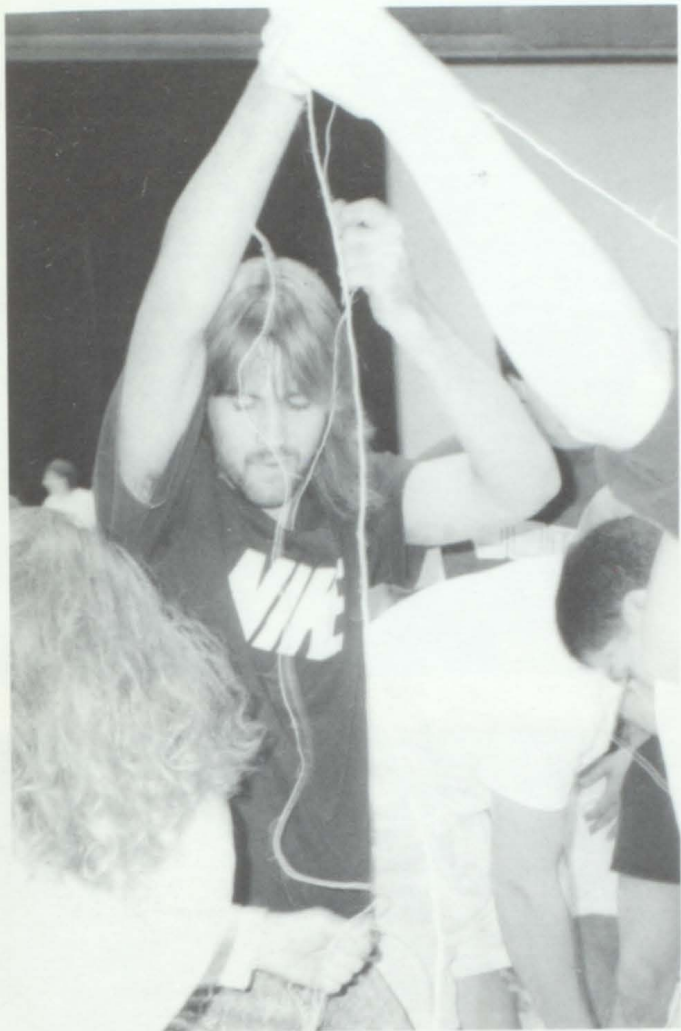
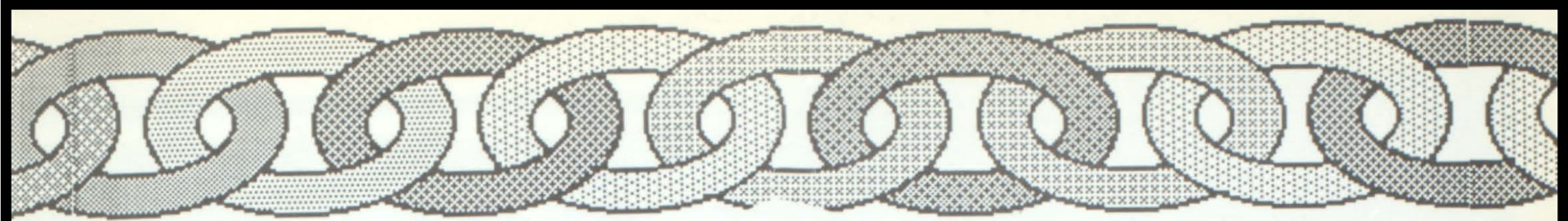

Snow on Valentines Day made Winter Carnival hectic for NHS members. Because lovebirds couldn't wait to see if they were remembered by that special someone.

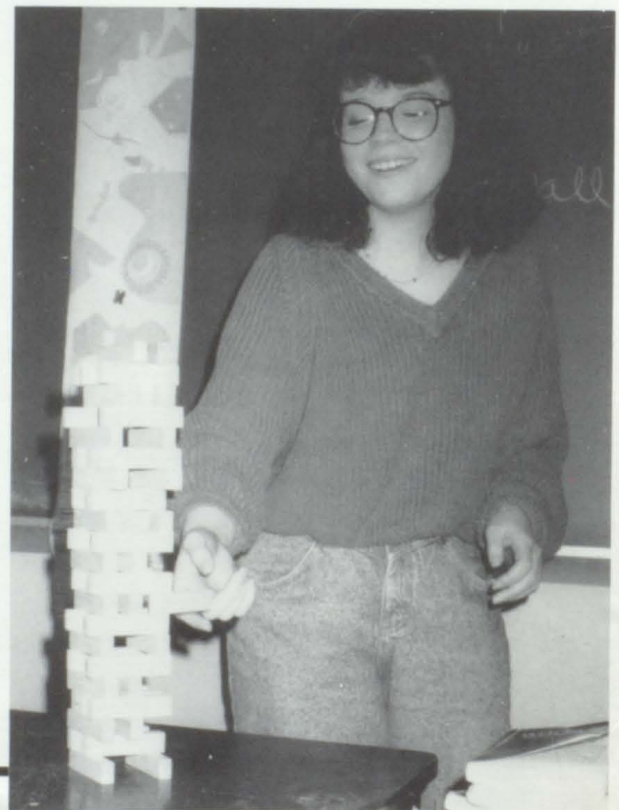

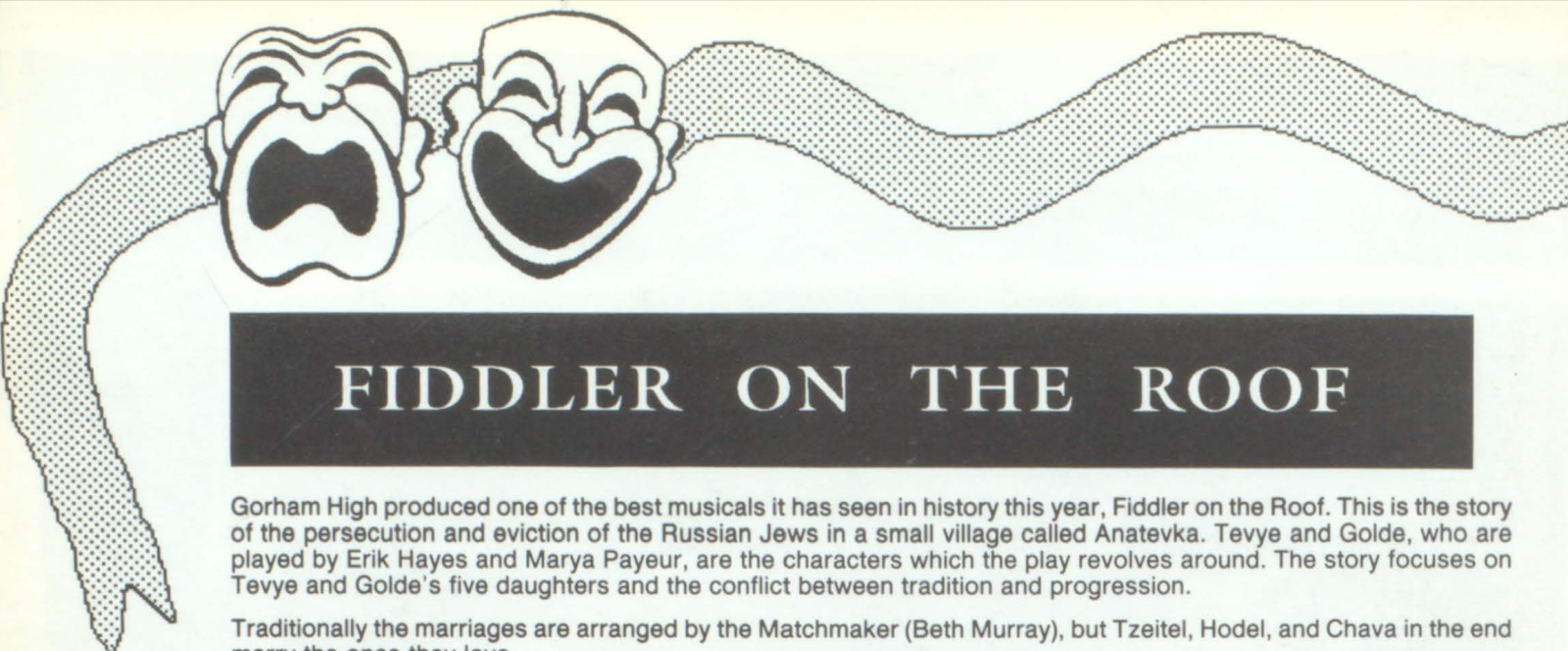

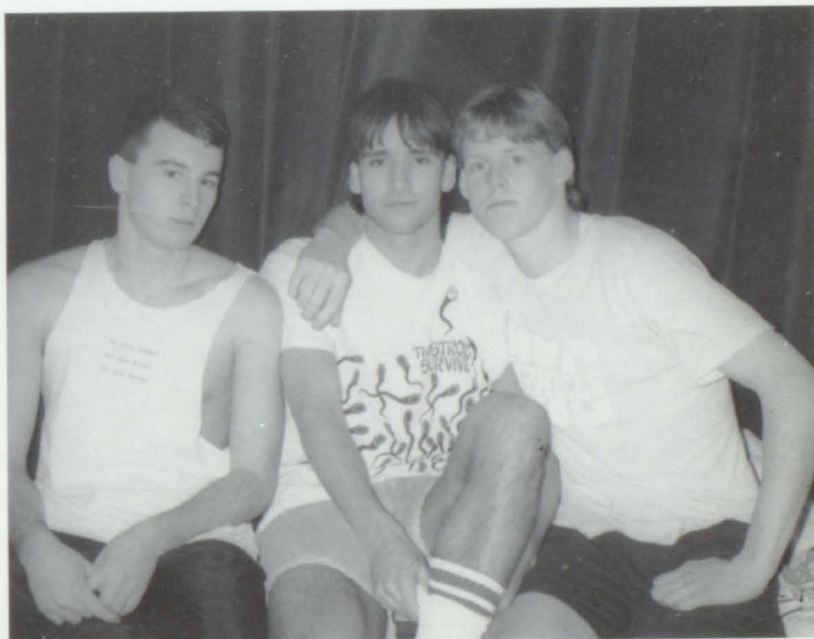

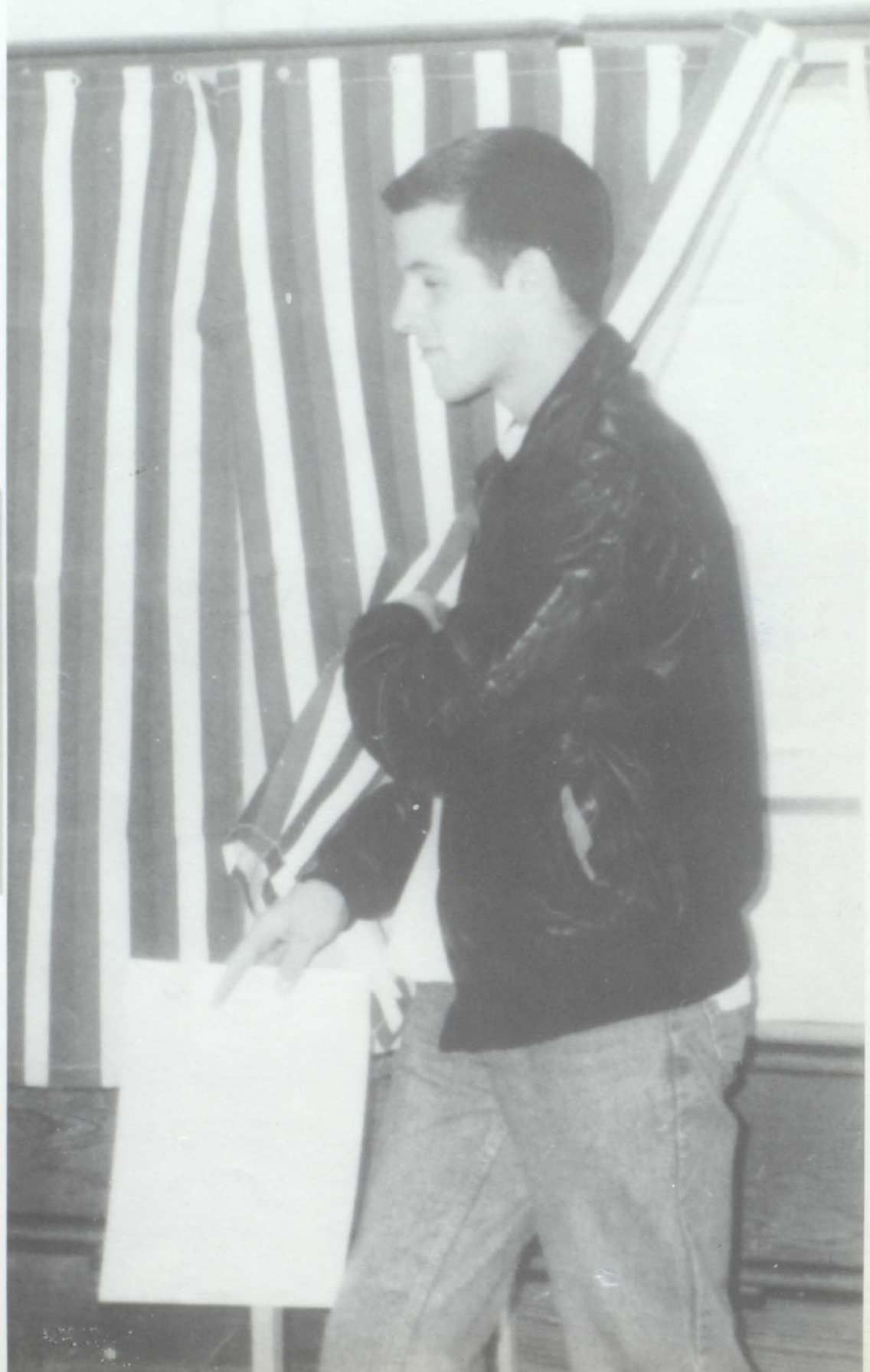

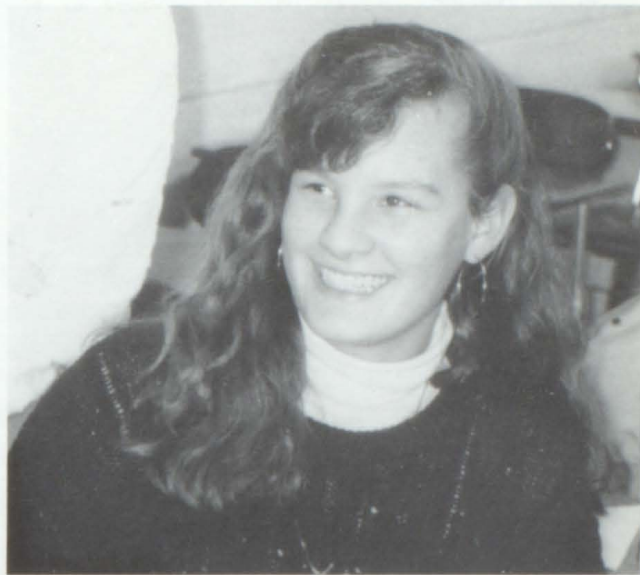
