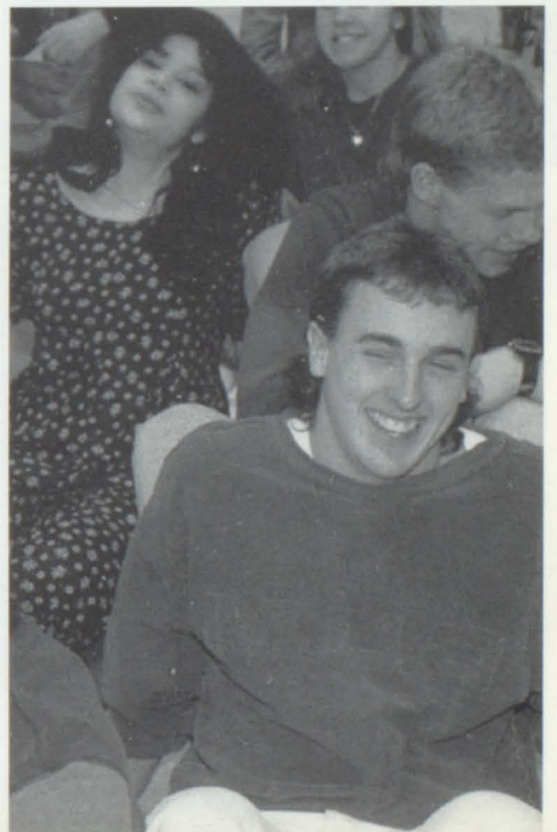
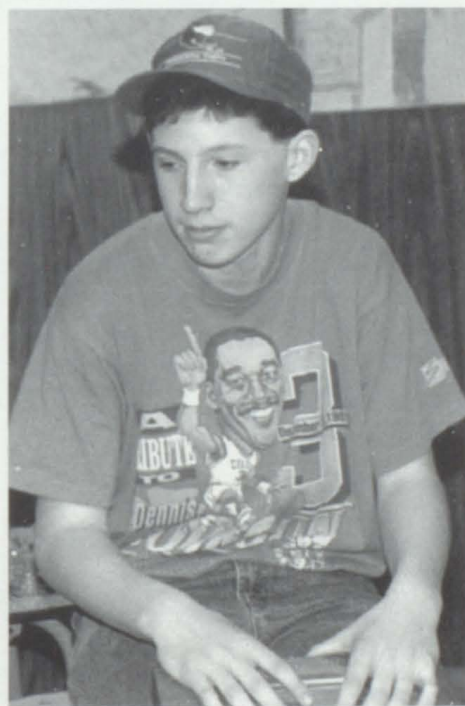
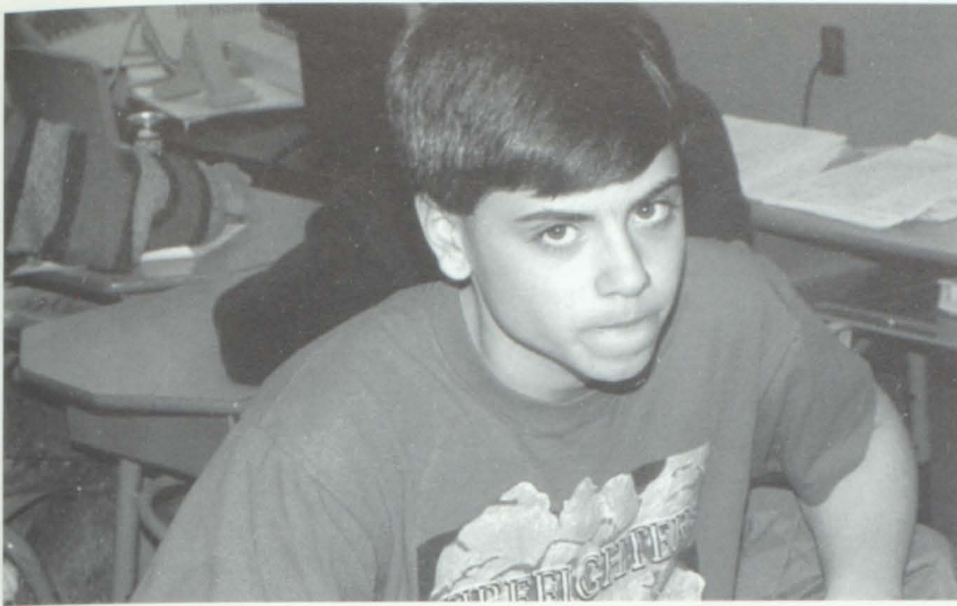


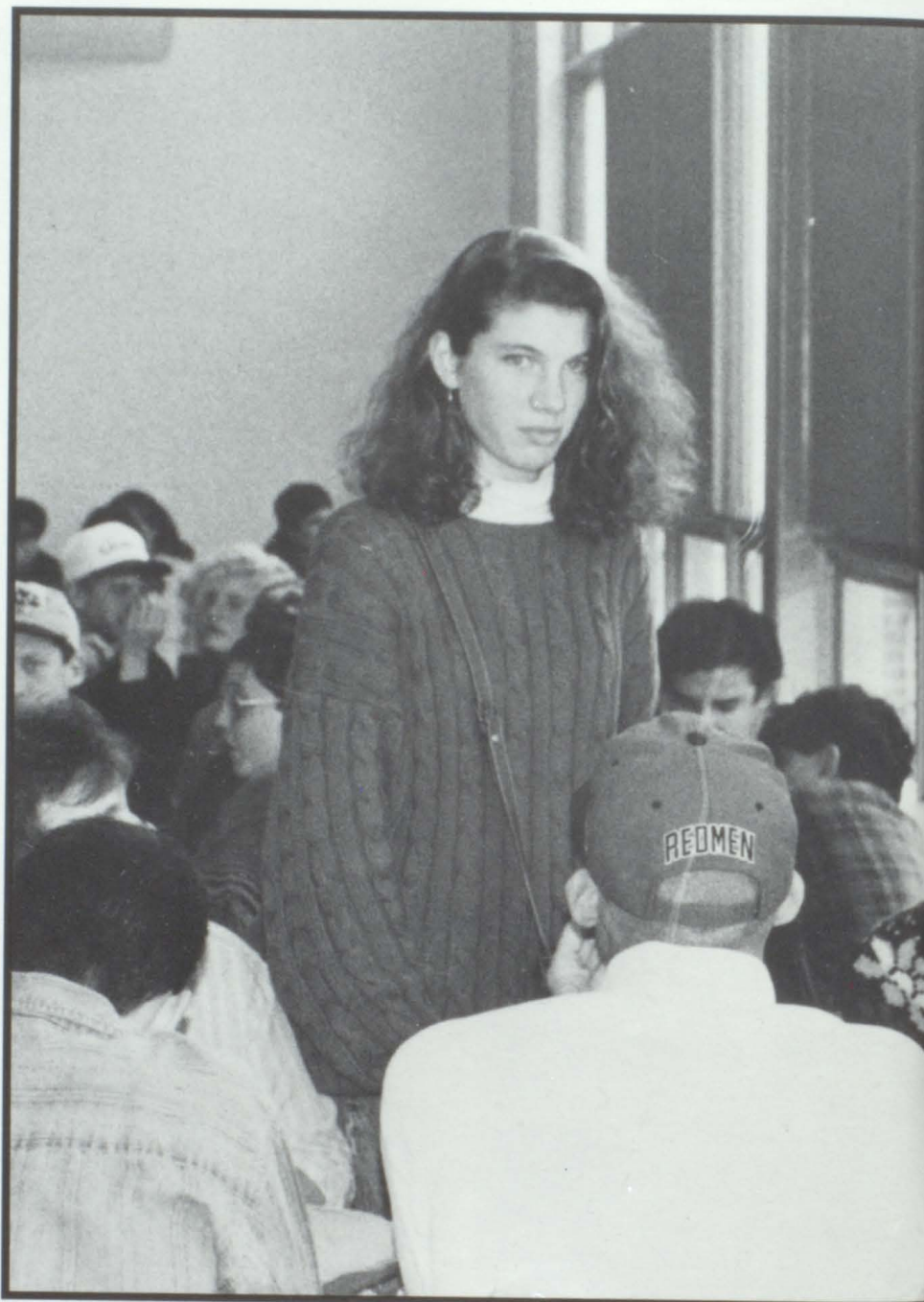
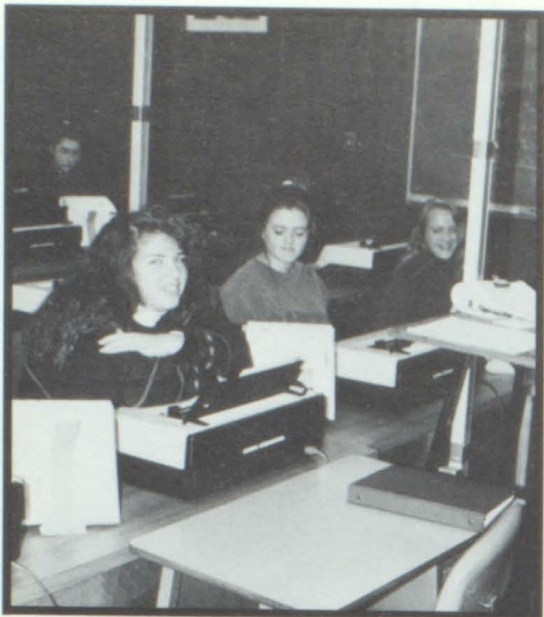


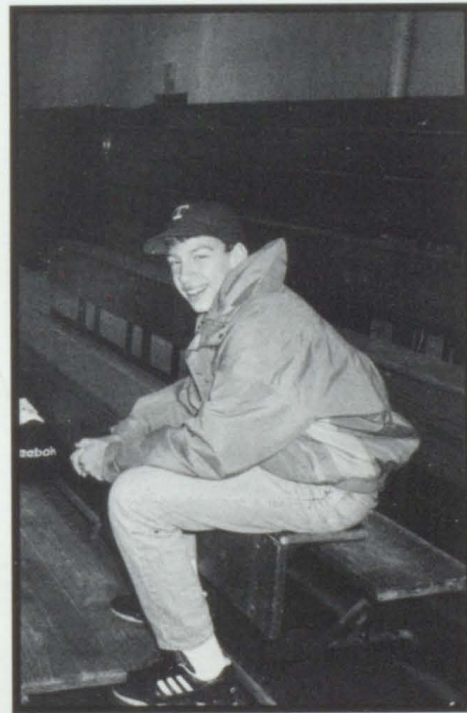
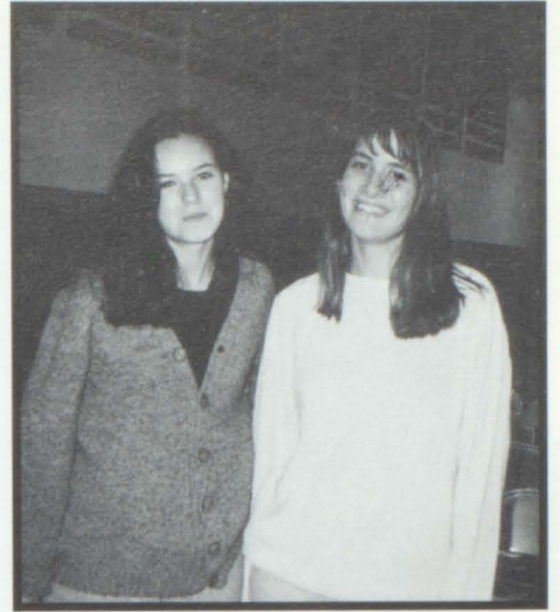








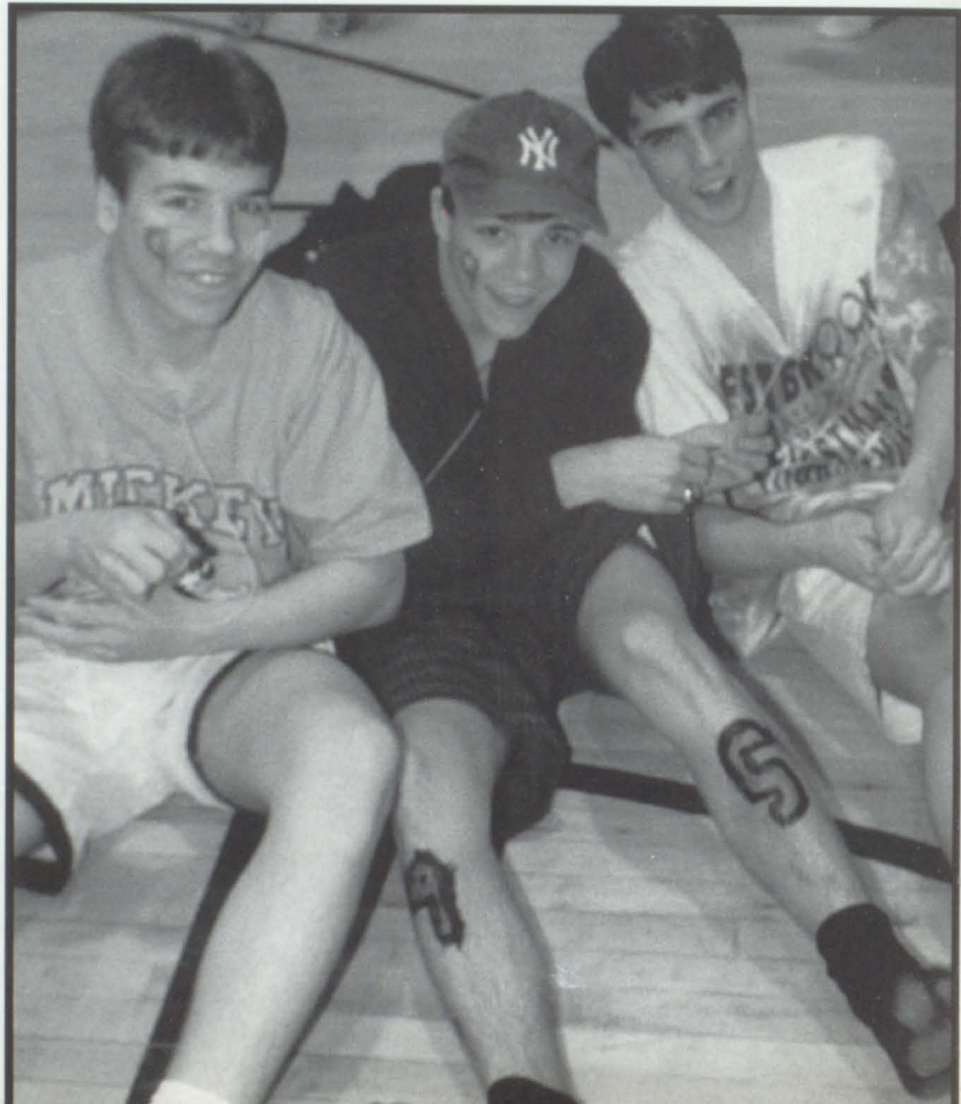




Winter Carnival

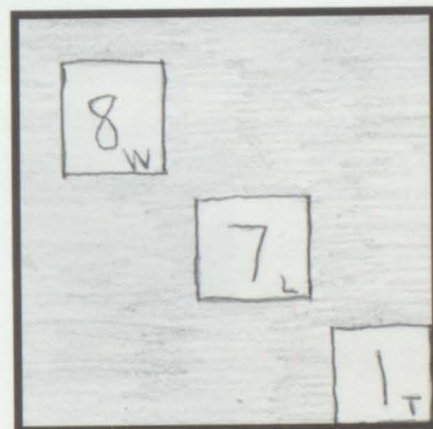


Boys Soccer
