

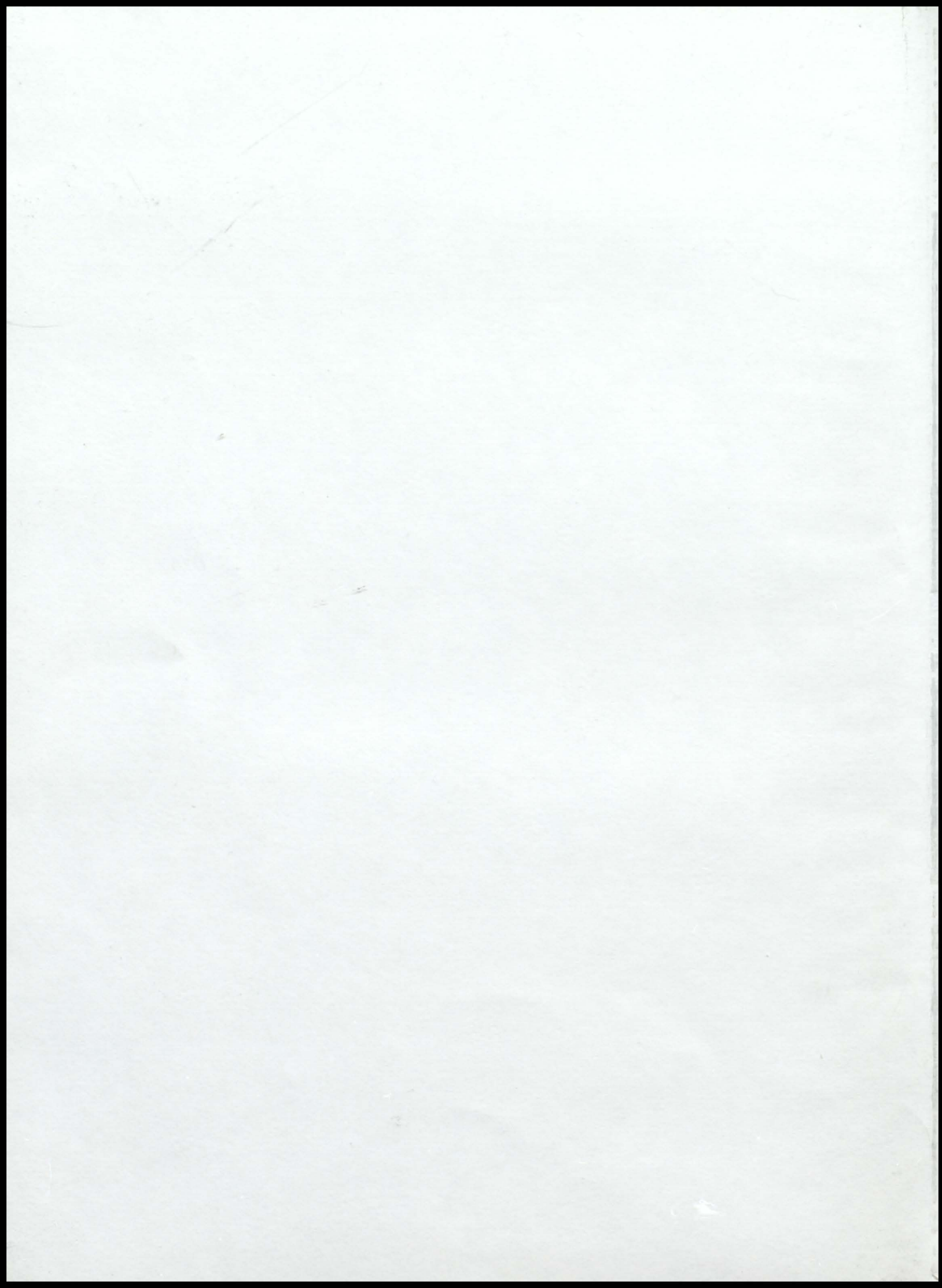

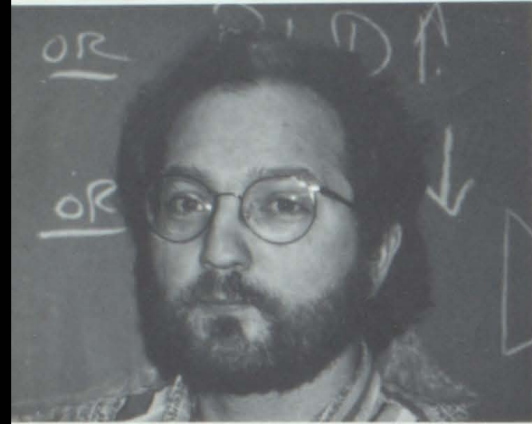
Teacher Dedication

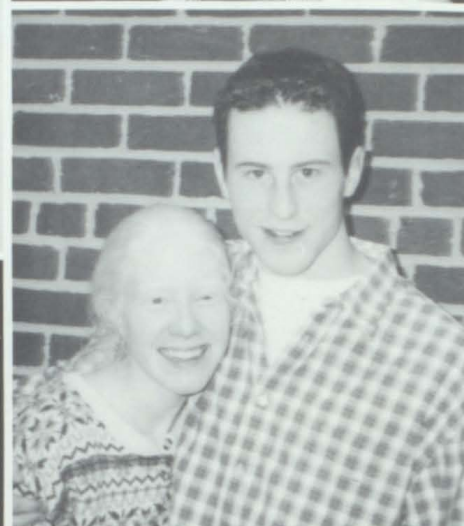
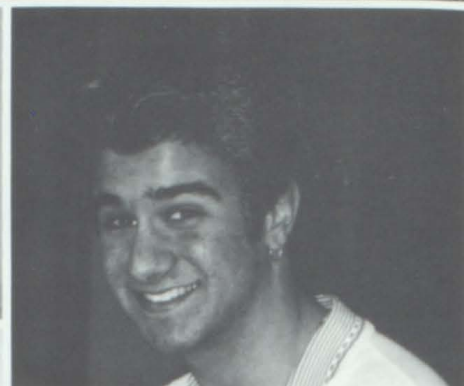
Class History



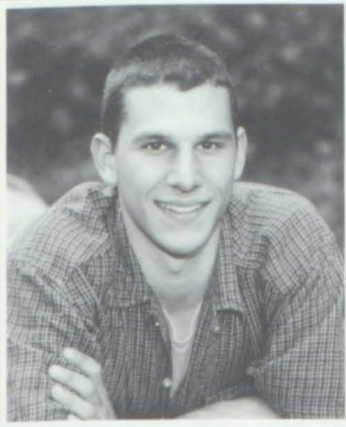

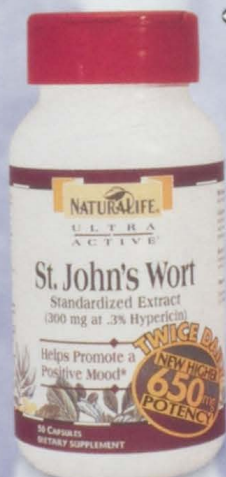

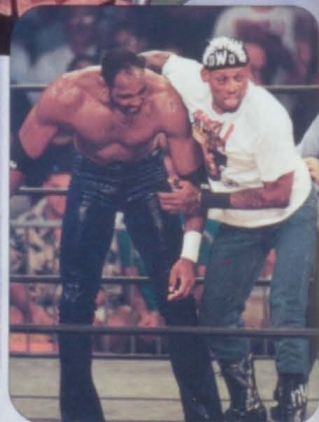

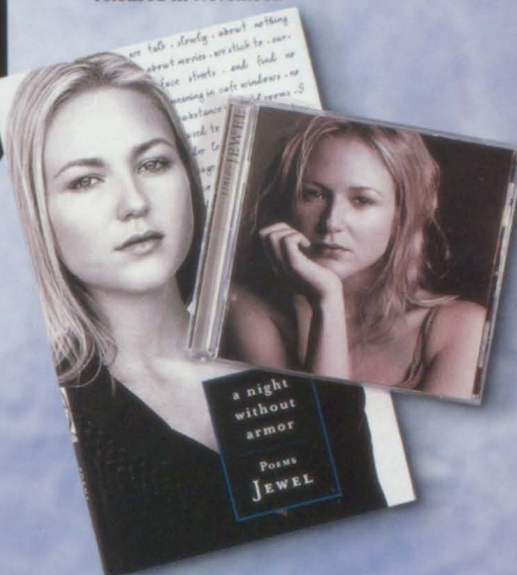

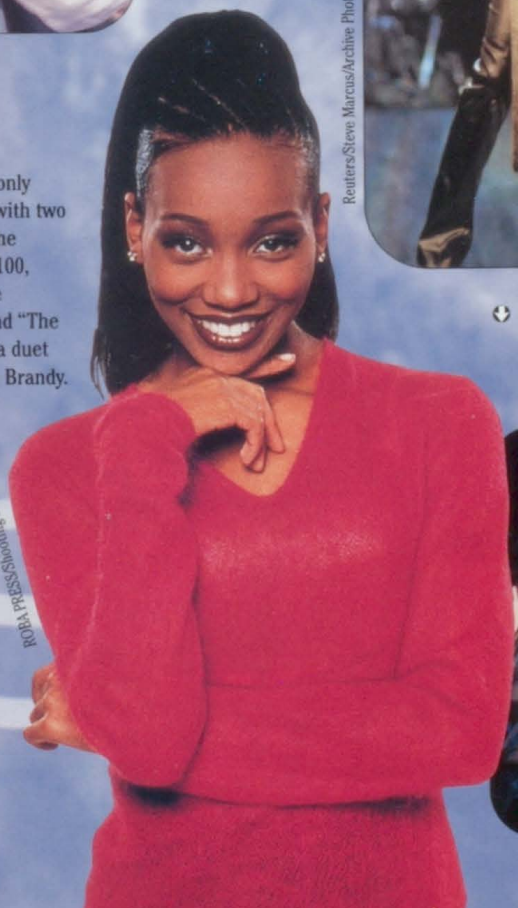

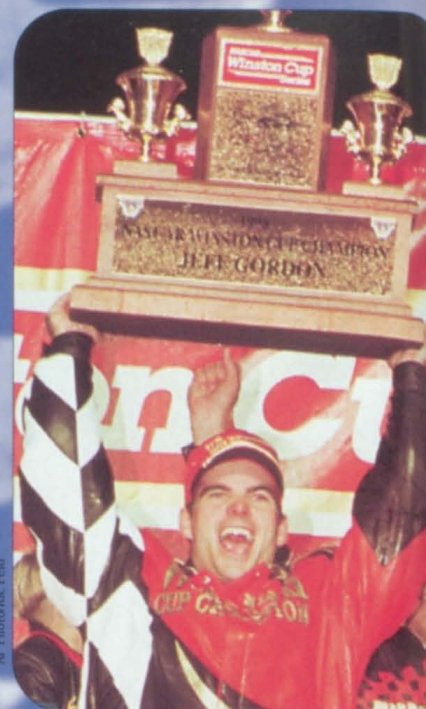

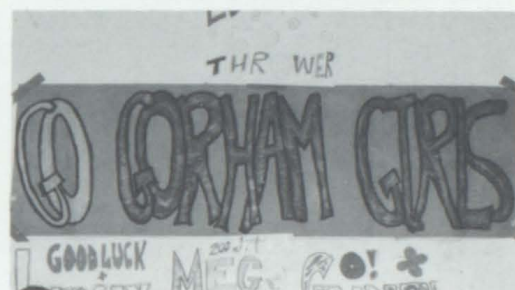
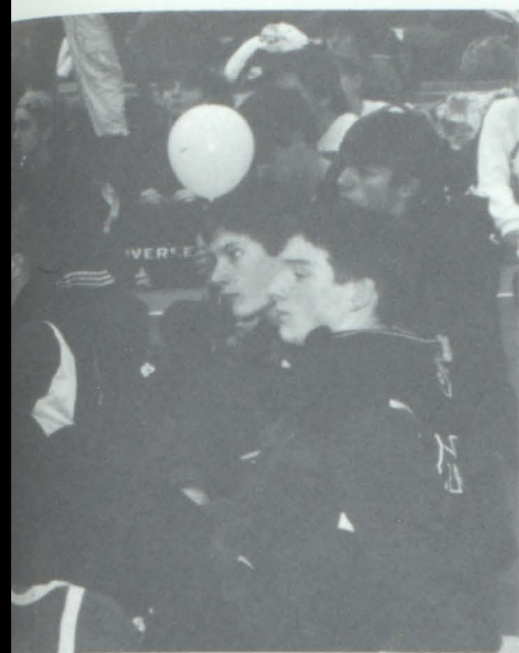
Indoor Track
