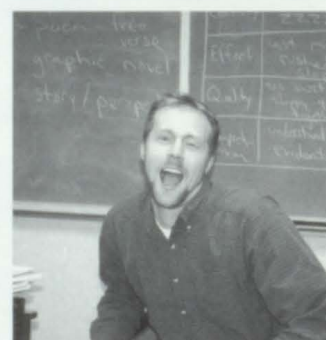
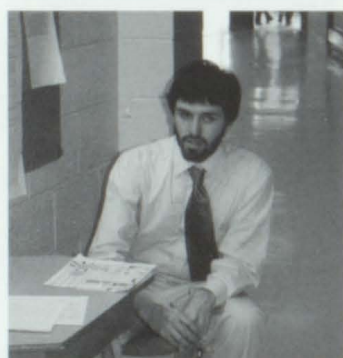
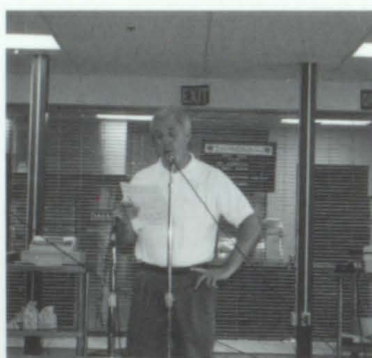
Ms. Stacey Mulrey

Naturally, this was followed with a new SAT, for it was only appropriate, after decades without change, that the test should be revolutionized just in time for our class to take it.

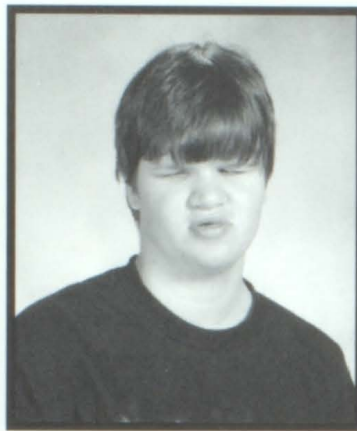

And -which is more- you'll be a Man my son!

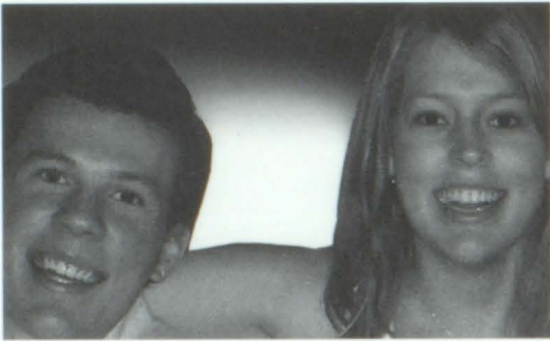
