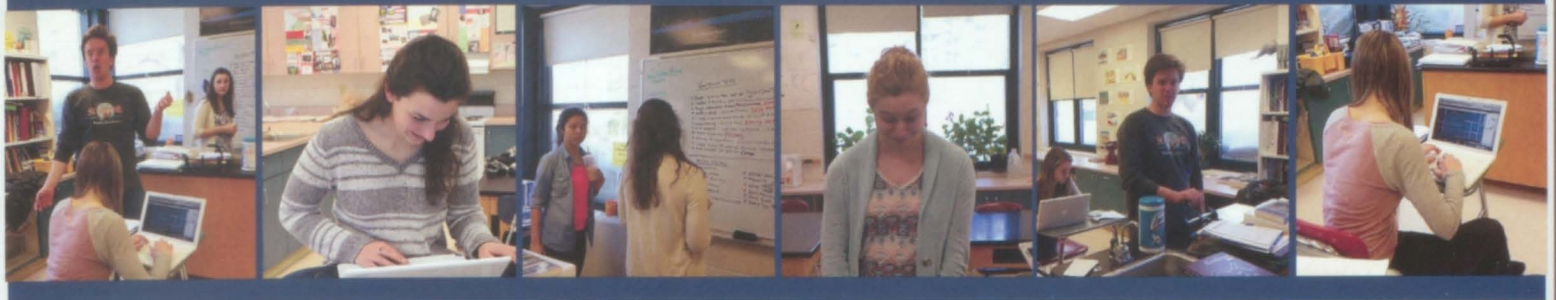








Yearbook
